Sufficiency economy approach has guidelines for sustainable agricultural management in three stages.


- Developing a self-reliant family farm in order to meet minimum needs with "New King's Theory"
- 2. Farmer cooperatives for selling surplus products
- Community expands its operations and interacts with other communities in larger scale activities

His Majesty's "New Theory" on Management Agricultural Land

His Majesty's concern about water shortages afflicting rain-fed farmers led to the promotion of his plan for small scale farm management. According to the plan, each plot of between 1.6 and 2.4 ha is divided into four main sections as 30:30:30:10

A system of individual ponds, a community reservoir and a larger basin is recommended. In case of drought, the dried-up pond will be filled in by the next largest in the hierarchy.
